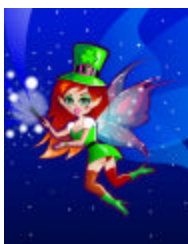
March 20th

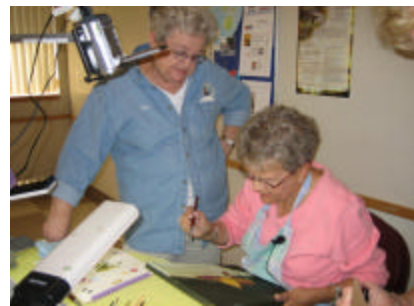

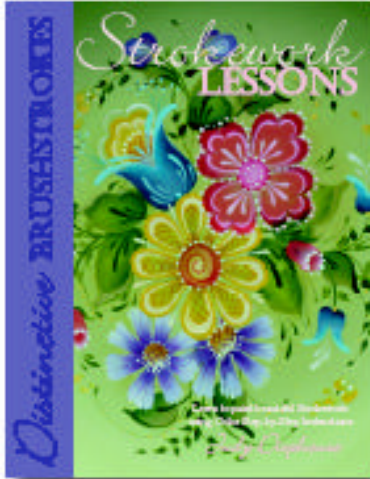
